

Admitting time is between 8:00 and 9:00 AM the morning of surgery

NO FOOD THE NIGHT BEFORE SURGERY AFTER 10 PM-We ask that you please do not feed your pet after 10:00pm the night before the surgery and **NO FOOD** the morning of the procedure. Your pet can have some water, we just need to avoid them having a full meal.

BATHROOM BREAK- Please allow plenty of time for your pet to freely evacuate their bowels and bladder before being admitted to the hospital. Dogs should be walked before admittance.

PRE-EXISTING PROBLEMS- When you arrive for surgery your pet will be weighed by our veterinary staff and obtain any pertinent history about your pet. Please, let us know if your pet has exhibited any signs of illness, has had a recent decrease in appetite, or is on any medication at your check in appointment.

DROP OFF APPOINTMENT- Please allow for 10-15 minutes for the surgical check-in paperwork and process. Like you, our greatest concern is for the well being of your pet and we do not want to rush the time needed to ensure we are offering you and your pet the best care we can offer.

COMMUNICATION- The veterinary technician will call you with an update after your pet's procedure. Every effort will be made to keep you up to date of your pet's status while in the hospital. Please ensure that you are reachable at all numbers given to us at check in. Please feel free to call and check on your pet at anytime while they are with us for surgery.
